

INTRODUCTION

This guide provides a simple explanation of the meaning of each card in the classic Tarot deck. However, reading cards is not just about explaining meaning but interpreting that meaning in the context of your life. That's a gift that all of our 7th Sense readers possess – otherwise, they wouldn't be 7th Sense readers.



The composition of the Tarot deck

There are 3 parts to a Tarot Card deck:

The Major Arcana Tarot card meanings connect to laws of the Universe

The Tarot archetypes represented in the Major Arcana (group of cards) are pictures that represent life and the stages and experiences we all go through.

The Minor Arcana Tarot card meanings reveal events that naturally occur due to laws of human nature

Minor cards describe the people, events, feelings and circumstances we encounter on our personal journey. They represent events that are within the control of the individual and indicate how you do something.

The Court Cards

These are contained within the Minor Arcana. The Page, Knight, Queen and King act as a bridge between the Major and Minor Arcana by describing various archetypal personality types.



THE MAJOR ARCANA

The Major Arcana in Tarot (22 Cards)
The Major Arcana are in some ways the most important cards in the Tarot deck.

A high number of Major Arcana cards in a spread indicates that it is now a time of high importance for the questioner.






THE FOOL

A need to make something solid, to solidify an idea, to build something with a firm structure. Authority / Control / Dominance. Man of power, an employer or a domineering male.






THE HIGH PRIESTESS




THE HIEROPHANT

This card can sometimes suggest marriage or a serious turn towards religion.






THE LOVERS






CHARIOT

Conflict within / Struggles and battles / Potential for victory / Resolution of quarrels / Moving forward / Overcoming opposition through confidence / Control and Determination / Trip.

TEMPERANCE:


Harmony within relationships.

Courage / Inner Will / Optimism.






THE HERMIT

A time for withdrawal, silent meditation and solitude. Patience is needed to confront one's inner world. Could be someone who likes to or needs to work alone.






THE WHEEL OF FORTUNE

THE HANGED MAN

Sacrifice must be made to gain something of greater value. It is all about waiting, in order to allow new possibilities to arise. Vulnerability / Selflessness / New Perspectives. A willingness to adapt to changed circumstances is the main theme of this card.





DEATH

The most misunderstood card in the deck.

The end of something which has been lived out, transformation, new beginnings to follow.

Death indicates a time of significant change and transition.





THE DEVIL

A confrontation with the inner world. Facingfears and inhibitions can foster growth. The Devil reflects actual addictions and dependencies in your life, such as alcoholism, drug-taking, unhealthy relationships, overspending., etc. Breaking

of habits and ceasing to dance to the devil's tune.






THE TOWER

Breaking down existing forms, changing false structures and finding true values. Change around the home or emotionally challenging periods - a time of great upheaval. It symbolizes conflict and overall disruption of life, but for the greater good.

It's about facing things you have been reluctant

to deal with. It could lead to good or bad things, but this action needs to done.

Fluctuation, uncertainty, confusion.





THE MOON

Time of passivity rather than action.

The Moon is a card of psychic forces, so let go of your conscious mental blocks and allow your intuition to guide you.

Optimism, time of passive action, energy





THE SUN

in abundance, a time of clear vision.

It is about embracing your destiny and giving it everything you have got. Happiness / Success / Good health. This card relates to achievement, at work or through studies. Travel to a warm or tropical climate.

Time for reaping rewards for past actions,

and reaching conclusions. You have reviewed and evaluated your past experiences and have learned from them. "Rebirth" or renewal of the self, changes to the better: getting well after a long sickness, or finding a new career or spiritual path.

THE WORLD

the realization of a goal or the completion of a cycle. This card can indicate world travel. Feeling of being welcome anywhere you go.

THE MINOR ARCANA

The Minor Arcana (Including the Court Cards

The Minor Arcana: (covering preoccupations, activities and emotions) highlights the more practical aspects of life and can refer to current issues that have a temporary or minor influence.

If a Tarot reading is predominantly made up of the Minor Arcana Tarot cards, you are dealing with issues which will not necessarily having a lasting influence on your life.

The Court Cards: Within the Minor Arcana are the Court Cards - Page, Knight, Queen and King. These cards most often represent people: ourselves, our thoughts, people in our lives and personalities, a level of maturity.

They may relate to behaviour or situations in some cases. PAGES conceive ideas, KNIGHTS act upon ideas, QUEENS nurture ideas and KINGS develop ideas to an established and stable state.

Upsurge of feelings and emotion, new relationships. Love affair, the birth of a child.





Sentimental time.






SEVEN OF CUPS

Leaving past behind. Letting go,






EIGHT OF CUPS

Imagination and Creativity and work issues






ACE OF WANDS

A stage of initial completion of a creative project. New ideas forming. New forces of energy being generated.






FOUR OF WANDS

A time to pause for celebration after hard efforts (holiday, period of rest and relaxation). "The Marriage Card".






FIVE OF WANDS

Public acclaim, promotion, recognition for work and effort (winning a scholarship, gaining a qualification, getting a lead role, publishing a book or success in any other chosen field).






SEVEN OF WANDS

Stresses and Worries of Everyday Life






ACE OF SWORDS

Inevitable and irrevocable change. Awakening of mental powers which may cause conflict at first but are ultimately conducive to growth and development.








TWO OF SWORDS

Stalemate; nothing can move or change, a situation of great tension, deep hostility, yet nobody mentions it. An impasse has been reached.





THREE OF SWORDS

Quarrels and conflict, a period of stormy weather for relationships. The card implies that something sad or painful must be allowed to work itself out. Heartbreak.





FOUR OF SWORDS

A need for rest or retreat after stress, a time for convalescence after tension.





FIVE OF SWORDS

Pride must be swallowed, limitations accepted, before further progress can be made. We have to work within the framework of that situation.





SIX OF SWORDS

A card of harmony. A period of calm after great anxiety, release of tension, a peaceful journey towards smoother waters (sometimes physical move away from unpleasant surroundings).



SEVEN OF SWORDS



SEVEN OF SWORDS

A need for evasion and avoidance of direct confrontation in order to achieve objective. Use brain, tact, diplomacy, rather than brawn and aggression





EIGHT OF SWORDS

A fear of moving out of a situation of bondage, paralysis. (Indicates a situation of tension similar to Two of Swords. In this case, however, the choices are perfectly conscious).





NINE OF SWORDS

A time in which the mind is tormented by fears of impending doom. Nightmares and fantasies trouble the mind, even though the facts do not match the fears.

The end of a painful situation or state.

There emerges an ability to see a situation realistically. Once something is ended, the way is cleared for a fresh start.

Clear break.






PAGE OF SWORDS




QUEEN OF SWORDS

Meeting an intelligent and charming, high principled person. Symbol of intellectual power and authority. Professional advisor. Develop logic and reasoning powers.





Body and Material Needs and Finances






ACE OF PENTACLES

A satisfactory time. Initial completion of work, a basic structure is built which still requires the finishing touches.






FOUR OF PENTACLES

Financial loss and hardship. Loss of luck / health. Loss on a deeper level; of esteem, of faith in oneself / life.






SIX OF PENTACLES

Help from a generous friend or employer, a situation in which there is money or good fortune to be shared.






SEVEN OF PENTACLES

A difficult decision must be made, between material security and uncertain new opportunities. This is a card about patience and letting things ripen.






EIGHT OF PENTACLES

Spirit of determination and earthy practicality is due to enter your life. A person of integrity. Someone who can be counted on.






QUEEN OF PENTACLES
